New Database: Dissertations & Theses



Have you ever wanted easy access to dissertations and theses?

Now you have it!

ProQuest Dissertations and Theses database offers full-text access to more than 1 million titles that are available for download in PDF format. Most dissertations published since 1997 are available in full-text form. Those for prior years

may be limited to a 350 word abstract written by the author or a simple citation. Indexing and citations date back to 1743, from institutions around the world, and number nearly 3 million.

An advanced search feature enables searches by producer and date. The Website also offers access to films by broad subject categories, with additional subject subdivisions within each category. Other options include access to either an entire film or to specific subject segments. New content is added periodically, while some older content is removed. Check it out to see what's changed.

Library Tip: Online Renewals




Did you know that you can use our Website to renew the loan period for items checked out from Clarion University Libraries?

Computer Tip: Excel Charts Can Be More Interesting!

A picture speaks a thousand words. The point of a chart is to visually show what the numbers already support. Charts don't have to be stiff, and boring. The columns in column charts don't have to be red, green, and blue.

- 1. Create the chart normally.
- 2. Click once on a column and all columns will be selected. Click a second time and only that column will be selected.
- 3. Double-click the selected column and click in the color selection area.
- 4. Select the Picture tab.
- 5. Click the Select Picture... button.
- 6. Find the desired picture for the right effect. Click twice.
